- Describe your contributions and accomplishments throughout your career

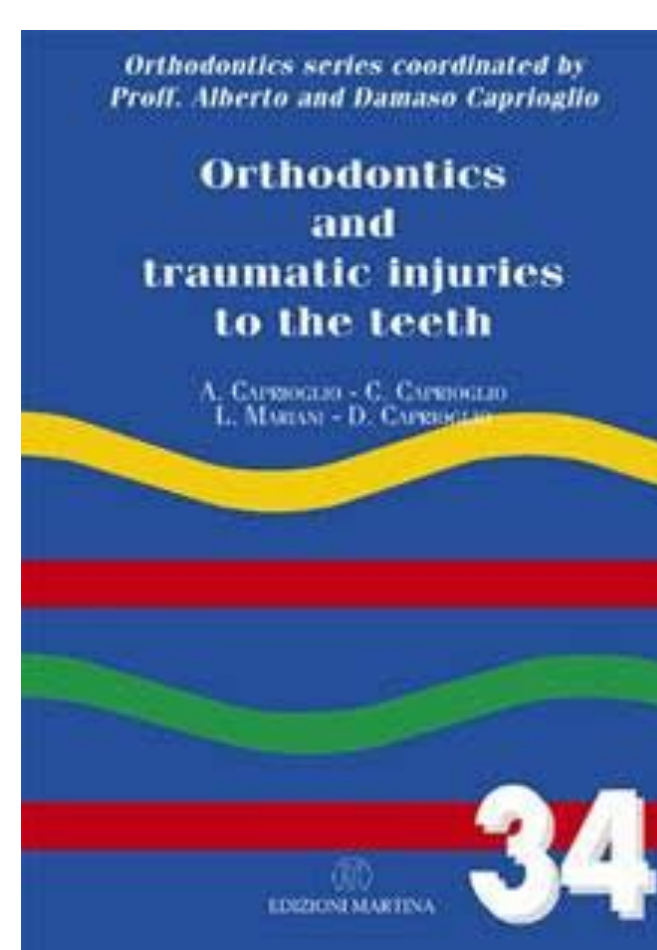
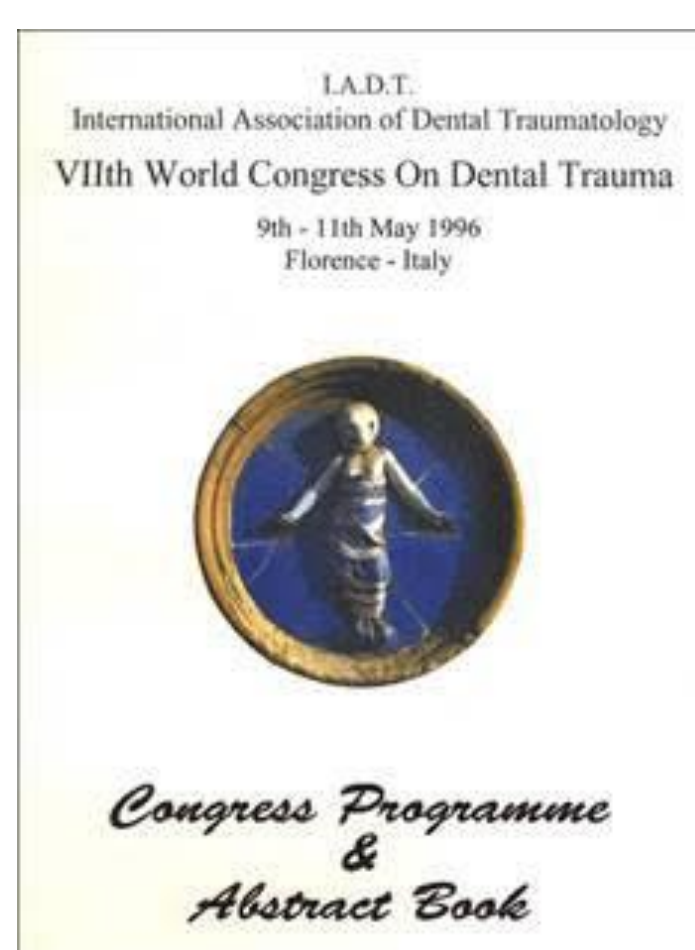
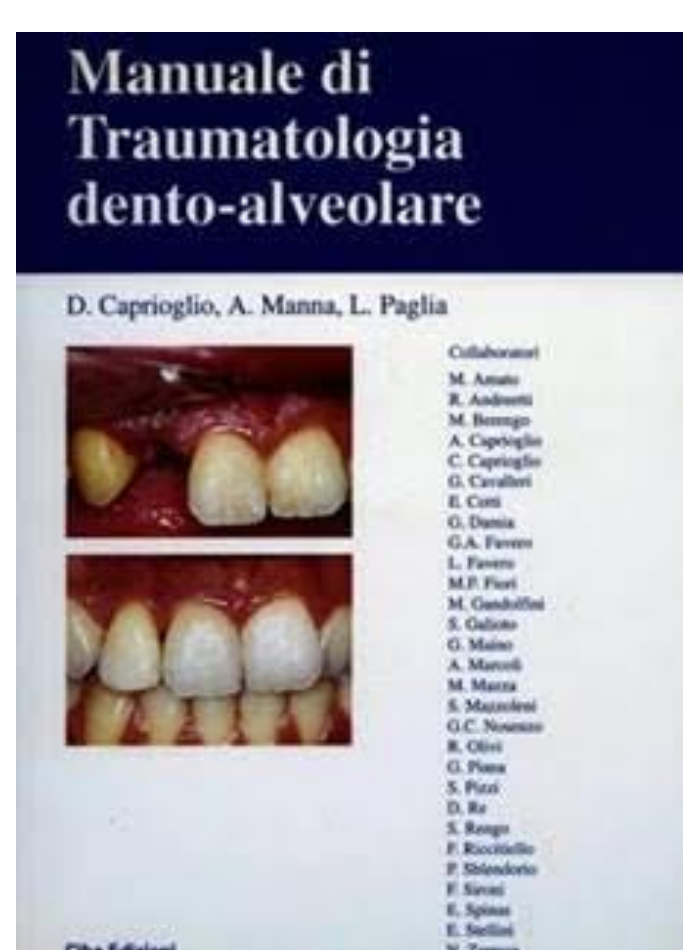
